


DRUMMOYNE WOMAN OF THE YEAR

I was delighted to attend the Woman of the Year event in Parliament House with Drummoynes's Woman of the Year, Associate Professor, Dr. Judith Trotman.

Dr. Trotman is the Director of the Clinical Research Unit at the Haematology Department of the Concord Cancer Centre. She is responsible for a team conducting clinical trials and developing innovative therapies for Leukaemia, Lymphoma, Myeloma and other blood disorders.

She told me the centre relies heavily on local fund raising to support its research. Dr. Trotman is recognised internationally for her work in haematology. She established the bone marrow transplant service at Concord in 2005 and in 2010 worked in the Lymphoma Service in Lyon, France, within the world leading French lymphoma trials group.

She brings a wealth of experience to help cancer sufferers at Concord and is a worthy recipient of the Drummoynes Woman of the Year for 2016.
