Last week's speaker: Rashid Kotwal

Rashid Kotwal spoke to our club on the topic of "Sales Results in 90 days". He positioned his talk in the context of deciding on and pitching for a charitable (Rotary Service) project. Rashid took us through the (strangely titled) DICTATE process to do this, which thankfully was an acronym that goes something like: Drill into the pain of the problem you're trying to solve; Determine the Interval (timing for the project); Assess the Costs; What has to happen to **T**ry and fix the problem?; Take Action (or not); Talk less (act more); and take the Emotions out of play.

We played this process out with several of our current projects under consideration: Central Australia Native Garden Project; and Sri Lanka Hospital Beds and Wheelchairs project. The process served as an eye-opener for us as we were faced with some challenging questions during the process.

This was a very interactive and engaging discussion with much interest in the room. There was a lot of ground covered, but the three points that stuck with me were:

- Sales (or selling) is really Service, and should be seen as such. We're trying to solve others' problems
- 2. When selling, you are selling feelings, not rational ideas. People buy on emotion and rationalise the decision later
- 3. When selling an idea to others, we must first sell it to ourselves. If we're not 'buying' how can we expect others to?

In the end however, Rashid was not able to sell me the Rotary Thank-you pen I presented him with!
