Two weeks ago, we welcomed Sonya Furlong, who's topic was Increase influence in business. Underlying the topic is Neuro-Linguistic Programming (NLP).

The topic covered many interesting areas of applied psychology, from building your own confidence to deal with difficult personalities in your daily life. 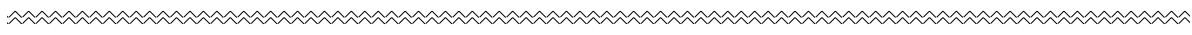
