"Old member" becomes a "new member"

Last Friday, 6 July, Keith Stockall and Rod Mc Dougall attended the Rotary Club of Sydney Cove (RCSC) to support Kevin Beltrame, a well-respected old member of this club, on the occasion of his induction as a new member RCSC. Kevin was formally introduced by Robert Lee a member of RCSC and previously a member of our club.


The Rotary Club of Sydney Cove was Chartered in June 1988, currently has 90 members and is one of the 50 clubs within Rotary District 9750.

Strathfield Rotary's Long Memorial

On Friday, 6th July, IPP Trevor Duxbury and PP Rod McDougall represented Strathfield Rotary at a memorial service at Rookwood Cemetery for Constable Samuel Long, who was shot and killed while investigating a burglary at the Royal Hotel in Auburn at about 2.00am on Monday, the 19th January, 1903. The service was the contribution by the Flemington Local Area Command to the year long 150th anniversary celebrations of the formation of the NSW Police Force. After the epitaph, read by Superintendent Philip Rogerson APM, of the Flemington LAC, and an address by the Acting Police Commissioner, Catherine Burn APM, yellow roses were placed on the grave, including one from Strathfield Rotary. The service ended with a short address by Mrs Helen Brake, a descendent of Constable Long. Later, at Auburn police station, a commemorative plaque, designed by Rod McDougall and purchased by a donation from our club, was unveiled. The plaque will eventually be placed in a prominent position at the location of the nowdemolished Royal Hotel, following the redevelopment of the site, probably as a public park or reserve. In the meantime, it will be mounted and put on display at the Police Station at Auburn. As well as details about the tragic happenings on that fateful night and of Constable Long,

the plaque also carries an acknowledgement of the contribution made by the Rotary Club of Strathfield. When in place it will be a constant reminder that one of the common goals of Strathfield Rotary and the law enforcement agencies of NSW is to make our local communities safer and better places in which to reside.
